A. Spiritual Growth is Gradual. Daniel 6:7-10
(p.819)

God does not hurry in His development of our Christian life. He is working for eternity. Growth requires TIME as much as effort.

B. Spiritual Growth often occurs in the context of Community. Daniel 1:8-16

As I make it a priority to connect with other Christ-followers, I see so much more of what God is doing.

C. Christianity is not for Wimps. Daniel 3:8-18

It is a huge challenge to *die to self*.
...to *consider others more important than yourself*.
...to *resist sin*.

D. Spiritual Growth occurs more by Inhabitation than Imitation. Daniel 3:24-30

In a way that is miraculous, God's **Holy Spirit** does the work of transformation in our lives. 2Cor.3:18; Php.2:13

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Faith Steps for Spiritual Growth

- ❖ Start reading the Bible daily
Read what you can. Read something every day. Don't worry about the parts you don't understand; worry about the parts you do understand.
- ❖ Join a ministry team and serve
- ❖ Give regularly and generously
- ❖ Share the Gospel with someone

- ❖ Attend the 2-hour course, *Intro to Northwest Chapel*, Feb.9
- ❖ Encourage a missionary through monthly correspondence
- ❖ Evaluate and prioritize my time with God's priorities
- ❖ Get connected through men's or women's ministries
- ❖ Apply a specific Scripture in my life
- ❖ Go on a Mission Trip to Washington D.C., Mexico, or...
- ❖ Confess my sins to God regularly
- ❖ Forgive and heal a relationship
- ❖ Meet with a Pastor to better understand the Gospel
- ❖ Commit to a Bible Study
- ❖ Pray weekly with my family
- ❖ Invite a friend to church
- ❖ Get baptized, Feb.12
- ❖ Attend Communion on Palm Sunday
- ❖ Memorize Scripture
- ❖ Attend church more regularly
- ❖ Learn my spiritual gifts
- ❖ Join a *Life Group*- new groups are just starting
- ❖ Call monthly to encourage a shut-in
- ❖ Read a challenging Christian book
Crazy Love by Chan; *Mere Christianity* by Lewis; *The Body* by Colson; *Radical* by Platt
- ❖ Spend 5 minutes before worship preparing my heart; then worship with abandon
- ❖ Begin each day yielding to the Holy Spirit
- ❖ Thank God often for His many blessings
