**A. Deity      1:1-10**

Hebrew *bara*, Latin *ex nihilo* = out of **nothing**.

In the beginning, **God!**  
Romans 1:20

**B. Design      1:11-13**

David Wilkinson puts forth this pattern to God's creative plan:

<sup>2</sup> Now the earth was...

**formless**      and      **empty**

Day 1 Separation of light / darkness	Day 4 Creation of lights to rule the day & night
Day 2 Separation of waters to form sky / sea	Day 5 Creation of <b><u>birds</u></b> & fish to fill the sky & sea
Day 3 Separation of sea from the dry land	Day 6 Creation of animals & humans to <b><u>rule</u></b> the land

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### C. Diversity

“...according to its own kind.”
