

Help for a Leaky Bucket (The Fading Glory) Exodus 33-34 (p. 67)

Last week... the multitude grumbled against God. Although many were judged and killed, God's mercy was greater and He put up with them. And Israel survived.

They arrived at Mt. Sinai where God gave them the 10 Commandments and established His covenant with His people.

A. Approach God with Reverence 20:18-21; 33:18-23

We must learn to balance reverence (Heb. 10:31) with confidence based on Christ's redemptive work (Heb. 4:16).

B. Time with God Transforms 34:27-31

God calls us to become like Christ. Romans 12:2

Some will not appreciate the changes (cp. 34:30).

C. We Must Visit God Regularly 34:32-35; 2Cor. 3:3-18 (pg. 1,064)

Like Moses, as soon as we leave God's presence, His glory starts to fade (or leak).
