

Children of the Burning Heart-Luke 24 (p. 974)

On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they came to the tomb, bringing the spices they had prepared. -Luke 24:1

A. Disciples 24:13-20

Powerful prophet- that's good, but a powerful prophet **can't save!**

B. Doubt 24:21-30

He could have darkened the sky or spoken with the sound of thunder.

Instead, Jesus- His identity still hidden- proceeded to teach them about the **Scriptures**.

Doubts diminish in view of the **cross**.

C. Demonstration of Deity 24:31-32

Then their eyes were opened...

Jesus conquered **death**.

All of us can identify with disappointment and doubt. When we face huge trials in life, we struggle. We long for a similar demonstration.

D. Devoted 24:33-47

This shows so clearly that faith takes **time to grow**.

These doubtful disciples, including Doubting Thomas, were radically changed.

Knowing Christ as your personal Savior changes everything. The victory of the cross makes it possible for everyone to be at peace with God.

Today you can receive salvation by faith.

A- Admit your sin and your need for a Savior.

B- Believe that Jesus died to pay your sin penalty and rose again offering forgiveness and eternal life.

C- Choose to follow Christ as Lord.

If you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.
