

The REAL GOD: *The Holiness of God*

When we recognize the *Holiness of God*, we are undone.
Isaiah 6

A. God's Holiness Encompasses Majesty and Moral Purity

The word *holy* means set apart, distinct, different, separate.
It means God is above all.

God's holiness refers to the absolute absence of evil and
encompasses all that is pure and righteous.

B. God Requires His People to Approach Him in Holiness

Leviticus 10:1 (pg. 95)

Aaron was Moses' brother. Nadab and Abihu were Aaron's
sons.

The purpose of the Old Testament Law was to revere
God's holiness and distinguish His people through holy
living.

Exodus 30:7-9

C. God Judges that which is Unholy

10:2-6

Exodus 30:36-38

Even the way you mourn makes a statement about God's
Holiness.

God does not want our creative expressions of worship as
much as He commands obedience. Our obedience flows
from our awe of His Holiness.

D. God's Holiness Calls Us to Distinguish between the Holy and the Common

10:8-11

Negative: Set apart from the ways of the world.

Positive: Set apart for the special purposes of God.

God says, "Be holy as I am Holy." -1 Peter 1:16

Application:

Only Jesus, God's Son, can satisfy the standard of our holy
God. You can receive His holiness by faith.

- **A**dmit that you have sinned and need a Savior.
- **B**elieve Christ died to pay for your sins and rose
again to offer forgiveness and eternal life.
- **C**hoose to surrender and follow Christ as Lord.
