2 Chronicles 17-20 (Pg. 397)

In the north, Ahab was the worst of the worst kings.
Meanwhile in Judah to the south...

A. DEVOTION to GOD

17:3-10

David, a man after God's own heart, was his ancestor.

Obedient living begins with a **mind focused** on God and His precepts.
Romans 12:2; Psalm 119:11; Psalm 19:7, 11

Jehoshaphat commissioned officials and Levites to **teach God's words** to the people.

Revival influenced surrounding kingdoms.

B. SPIRITUAL COMPROMISE

18:1-6; 19:2-3

Jehoshaphat made an alliance with **Ahab**.

Be cautious of spiritual compromise for the sake of expediency.

C. PRAISE and DELIVERANCE

20:2-29

Prayer of **need** and **trust**.

God's answer: the **battle** belongs to the Lord.

Miraculous deliverance as **musicians** led the way praising God.
