2 Chronicles 15 (Pg. 396)

Following Solomon's unwise demise, the nation split into North and South.

region	designation	tribes	capital	righteous kings
North	Israel	10	Samaria	0
South	Judah	2	Jerusalem	8

1 Kings 14:22-26
Judah did what was evil in the LORD's eyes. They provoked Him to jealous anger more than all that their ancestors had done with the sins they committed.

2 Chronicles 14:2-6
Asa did what was good and right in the sight of the LORD his God.

A. Renewed Sacrifice 15:8-10

The blood of sacrifices was a temporary covering; a **demonstration of faith** that they were trusting God to forgive their sin.
