or a stranger, or in the Old Testament.

A. King Manasseh had the Longest and most Wicked Reign in Judah's History 33:1-9

Everyone is **responsible** for their choice regarding God.

B. After all that Evil, God still chose to **Speak** 33:10

Listen to God **before** it is too late.

C. God severely Disciplined Manasseh 33:11 Hebrews 10:31

It is a **terrifying** thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

D. When he **Repented**, God showed GRACE and Restored Manasseh 33:12,13

What can we learn about grace?

1. If we confess, we are **forgiven** through faith in Christ.

2. We are **indebted** to God.

Matthew 18:32

3. Showing grace encourages the **Body**. 33:14,15,16

4. Showing grace attracts **others** to Christ.

5. Grace does not preclude **justification**.
