

Greater Than: **WARNING!**

Hebrews 2 (Pg. 1,100)

In chapter 1 we read a series of seven quotations from the Old Testament explaining that Jesus is God and is *greater than* angels. Here in Hebrews 2, he pauses to warn us to not neglect the superior revelation of salvation.

A. Warning Against Drifting

2:1-5

Salvation was conveyed through the Apostles and confirmed through signs and wonders and the Holy Spirit. (Acts 2:22)

How will we escape if we neglect such a great salvation? We **CANNOT!**

Hell is full of people who drift beyond the call of God into eternal damnation.

B. Christ's Resurrection is *Greater Than* the Power of Sin

2:6-10

Both humanity and Christ Himself were made a little lower than angels.

Here in Hebrews 2, the Holy Spirit clearly reveals that Psalm 8 was pointing to Jesus.

The sacrificial work of the cross was completed—**perfected**—when Jesus made atonement for sin.

C. Salvation Makes Us God's Spiritual Children 2:11-18

The word sanctify means to be *cleansed*, to become *holy*.

Since Christ is *the* Son of God and I become a son of God, Jesus refers to Christians as His **brothers/sisters**.

Satan often leads us to drift away from this great salvation through **distraction**.
